Is my data safe?	<p>Your data is encrypted on the device and during transfer to the App. The Bluetooth connection is only active if you have manually started it. It is immediately deactivated after synchronization.</p> 	<p>Your data is transmitted and stored encrypted on servers in the EU (Frankfurt, Germany). The EU is known for its stringent privacy and cyber security laws and standards, i.e. GDPR, ISO/IEC 27001, SOC 1/2/3 reports, BSI CS.</p> 	<p>A lot of the devices available on the market are connected permanently to your app. You lose control when your data shall be available to the app.</p> 
Who do you share my data with?	<p>Your Daysy doesn't share any data without your control. You can keep it to the device only.</p> 	<p>Only with our service partners (Valley Electronics US, Germany and Switzerland) and developers. However, without your unique serial number we cannot identify which data belongs to you. We do not share or sell your data to 3rd parties for the reason of advertisement, profiling, tracking or legal actions.</p> 	<p>Medical devices are very expensive to build, certify and sell. Selling customer data is a very tempting way to increase a companies net profit. Storing your data outside of the EU's GDPR may leave your data vulnerable to seizure by law enforcement.</p> 
Can I delete my data?	<p>Anytime without questions. Follow the procedure in the IFU and your data is gone.</p> 	<p>Anytime without questions. You can delete your whole account and any data saved on our servers within the app. We won't be able to restore your data. Period.</p> 	<p>Shared data with 3rd parties won't be deleted automatically. You might need to ask for deletion at them as well. That is, if you know who those 3rd parties are.</p> 
Is my data connected to my identity?	<p>Your data is connected to the Daysy serial number. No one can directly identify your data without the knowledge of the unique serial number of your Daysy.</p> 	<p>Valley doesn't know which data belongs to you. If you provide your serial number to the support team, we can identify your data and help with your device or provide you with the right service. It's in your hands with whom you share that information.</p> 	<p>Usually, your name and email address are linked to your data. Then it's very obvious to whom this data belongs.</p> 
Is my location stored or tracked?	<p>Your Daysy device has no means of storing or tracking location data.</p> 	<p>The DaysyDay app may ask for location permission on some Android OS versions, but this is solely an Android Bluetooth requirement so that the phone can scan for nearby devices, ie. the Daysy. The location settings on your phone are used to set the right language and time zone within the DaysyDay App.</p> 	<p>In several cases your exact location is tracked whenever a synchronization is initiated. From this information it can be assumed when and where you became pregnant, entered notes or had intercourse.</p> 
Can I request a copy of my data?	<p>You can download your data from your Daysy to a PC through the USB port.</p> 	<p>Yes, after you have shared your serial number with us we can send you a copy of your data in a human readable format.</p> 	<p>Once your data is shared with 3rd parties, you would need to ask them as well. Shared data is usually processed and new information generated. This should be your data as well and available to you anytime.</p>
